Sub: Incomplete & evasive information issued by the Respondent-Filing of appeal-reg: -

Ref: 1) My RTI application dated 03/09.2024 to the Respondent.

2)Information issued under No. CSL/SEC/CS/CORRESP/RTI/2024/1by the Respondent dt.27.9.24. of CPIO, Cochin Shipyard.

I am filing this Appeal before this 1st Appellate Authority (AA) as the reply dated 27/09/24 of the Respondent-CPIO is incomplete, unsatisfactory, untrue, and evasive amounting to a refusal of information, so defeating the noble objective of the Legislation (RTI Act-2005). Being a bonafide Citizen of India, I have moved a petition containing 11 points and sought reply under RTI-Act 2005(hereinafter referred as 'Act').

The designated officer CPIO had resorted to directing this applicant to visit the web site of the Company and get the information. This reply is very much inappropriate as if the CPIO is ignorant of the law of the land (Act). If it is the rule under the RTI there is no need to designate a CPIO and establish RTI Mechanism of CPIO to CIC. A simple notification in two local newspapers is enough to cater the RTI applicants' enquiries. The

CPIO ought to have appreciate the ownership of the company i.e. Govt. of India. He should have appreciate the authority of the Parliament, which passed the Act. The CPIO ought to have appreciate the statutory prescription of the Fee Rs.10/-as the cost of the information, which is clearly defined under the Rule under the Act. The prescribed Fee is paid and the same is credited to the Company account but unfortunately information is refused but a direction to visit website. All the information are in the custody of the CPIO if not the CPIO ought to have taken steps to get the information from the source, wherever it is by forwarding to the holder of the information under intimation to the applicant as laid down in the Act.

This appellant is astonished to note the observation of the CPIO

"Spread across the different files and the collection, and transmission will lead to disproportionate diversion of our available resources".

While making observation like this Ld. CPIO had swallowed the remaining portion of the Sub Section (9) of Sec.7.

S.7(9) reads

"An information shall ordinarily be provided in the form in which it is sought unless it would disproportionately divert the resources of the public Authority or would be detrimental to the safety or preservation of the record in question".

So, the S.7(9) is clear and without ambiguity. CPIO is bound act upon the statute and

proviso U/s 8 which reads:

"Provided that the information which cannot be denied to the Parliament or a state Legislature shall not be denied to any person."

If all the CPIOs across India are justified and saved like this the RTI Act can be put into waste bin.

This observation and connected outpouring of the CPIO is a matter of scrutiny by Parliament Subject Committee. The CPIO ought to have appreciate that there is a CSR mechanism in all PSUs, Board, Corporations and Government Departments across India including Supreme Court. None of the institutions could say shortage of time and resource. CSR too has CSR department headed by AGM. This Appellate Authority may please call in the connected records, peruse and satisfy yourself and direct the CPIO to deliver me point wise replies and information as laid down in the Act.

Grounds

Question No.1

The CPIO ought to have issued the information as stipulated under the Act. The stand of CPIO that information is available in your website is not acceptable. Ho should have compiled the information from the records of the company wherever it is, positively.

A Company secretary may be loaded with heavy work of the Board and Company matters. On that ground Cochin Shipyard cannot deny the information sought by a Citizen. Solution is the delegation of power to another officer.

Question No.2

This applicant has reasonable apprehension that selection of beneficiaries and fund distribution is not transparent.

The preamble of the Act is clear:

“And whereas democracy requires an informed Citizenry and transparency of information which are vital to its functioning and also to contain corruption and to hold Government’s and their instrumentalities accountable to the ‘Governed’.

The preamble of the Act is the tool for the interpretation of statute as per the legal jurisprudence. If the CPIO had studied the statute properly he might not have taken a stand contrary to the preamble. He ought to have taken the statute in the letter and spirit instead the CPIO had taken the Act leisurely and sent a directive to visit the website.

So the list of the beneficiaries and their Applications and project details are information needed to the applicant may be directed to issue.

Question No.3

CSR1 Registration and Niti Ayog Darpan Unique Id are mandatory for CSR fund. If any Government company grants fund to any entity without the these pre -requisite, it is a case of corruption, mismanagement and nepotism inviting CBI investigation.

Being an applicant with all mandatory requirements Dheevara Trust has bonafide right to know what is happening in the distribution of Fund in the Shipyard when our application is hard-heartedly rejected. This applicant wants CSR1 and Unique Id of all beneficiaries positively to satisfy that there is no discrepancy, discrimination and corruption in the distribution of fund.

Question No.4

We are not informed of the fate of our application. Now through this RTI reply it is informed that our application is incomplete. We are not given an opportunity of rectification if any. It is a case of Violation of Natural Justice which is the corner stone of Our constitution (Art.14). This aspect may be investigated by AA Seriously.

This applicant as Chairman of the Dheevara Trust along with our Gen. Secretary visited the AGM Mr. Sambath Kumar at 1 PM of June 2024 We had a detailed discussion with him, who even offered to visit one of the running sample project of a garment unit in Perumbalam Island. So the question of incompleteness of the application is untrue and lie unbecoming to the officers of a prestigious Company of India. The AGM ought to have given us any prescribed application if any then.

Question No.5,6,7:

This applicant wanted to know the degree of incompleteness and any other handicap in the application. That is why This applicant seeking the Questions under item No.5 ,6 and 7. Now the CSR department is taking inconsistent stand. This applicant is invariably wanted to know the reason for the rejection and day to day order sheets of scrutiny process as prescribed in any administrative office.

AA may please look into the statutory requirement u/s 4(3) with regard to the maintenance of the records of official business as a whole. If the shipyard is not maintain records of business, it is the failure of the management not guilty of citizens.

Question No. 8:

Arbitrary rejection of our application pointing to maleficed and biased decision of the concerned. Ours is a registered organisation with long history of social service qualified with NITI AYOG & MCA1 registration. The Trust is working among coastal population of the state. We apprehend that Caste and occupational repugnance may be the cause of Bias against us.

Cochin Shipyard is statutorily bound to reveal the no. of applications received, No. Of sanctioned applications, fund sanctioned, project details of sanctioned entities invariably.

Question No.9:

CPIO may appreciate that Shipyard is established in the fishing hamlet of Ravipuram and Mari Drive of Ernakulam. Hundreds of families of fishermen and poor peoples were removed for the shipyard project. There is Government orders regarding acquisition, Evacuation, Rehabilitation and establishment . As per the Act, It is the duty of the CPIO to forward the our application to the custodian/holder of the said records for necessary action. This simple duty is not undertaken by the CPIO.

The reply in its totality is highly evasive hence objectionable. It seems the CPIO does not appreciate the

objective of the RTI Act and the Legislators intend in the Act. CSR is the noble objective of the Govt. which bestowed upon the Corporates' their Social Responsibility.

It seems the Company is not serious in keeping datas and information. The reckless and evasive reply requires intervention of Competent agency. Neither CPIO nor the Management has power to refuse the questions by stating "available in public dominion". This kind of reply and approach of a public servant is irresponsible negating the relevance of the RTI Act. Does the CPIO want to throw out the Parliament made Legislation? It is an encroachment to the honour of the Parliament and making mockery of the system. Not only the Cochin Shiptard but all PSUs and Govt. departments are the property of Public. Whims and Fancies of the officers are matter of Concern. Highly paid and learned Officers should have minimum prudence to understand their limitation as public Servant.

CPIO had knowingly and intentionally errored and confused this appellant without giving the relevant information.

PRAYER

Respected AA is requested to call for the records and peruse it. AA may please direct the CPIO to issue the sough-in information unequivocally and forbear him from adopting anti-constitutional stand.

Reply provided by CSL

Since the application for CSR from DHEEVARA Trust was not recommended by the Executive Committee, the same was not placed before the CSR committee.

On perusal of the relevant documents, this Authority could find that the information provided above is correct.

Information sought by the Appellant

- (vii) Give the member wise opinion of the CSR committee on DHEEVARA Trust's application Countersigned by the appropriate authority.

Reply provided by CSL

Please refer reply to point no. (vi) above.

On perusal of the relevant documents, this Authority found that the application for CSR from DHEEVARA Trust was not placed before the CSR Committee (Board Level) of CSL on account of non-recommendation of the same by the Executive Committee.
