Monitoring of Status of Implementation of Public Procurement Policy (Preference to "Make in India")
as per DIPP Order Ref No. P-45021/2/2017-B.E.II dated 15th June 2017

- 1.1 The Hon'ble Prime Minister from time to time has been highlighting about the Policy of Public Procurement (Preference to "Make in India") at various Forums, both within the country as well as during his trips abroad. He stresses on "Atmanirbhar Bharat", "Vocal for Local", "StartUp India", apart from "Make in India". DIPP, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India have issued clear cut unambiguous guidelines referred above. The general perception is that when our Government is giving so much emphasis on "Make in India" and have issued specific guidelines, various Government Departments, CPSE's would have taken concrete measures for implementing the laid down policy.

1. Kindly provide me the present day status of implementation of DIPP, Ministry of Commerce and Industry order dated 15th June 2017 by your Organization.
 2. Please provide me value of indigenous procurement made by your Organization in terms of the order referred above for the Financial Year 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21 & 2021-22 and the total saving of Foreign Exchange made in the process by you.
 3. I understand that your Organization have uploaded the details of items procured under "Make in India" Policy for the Financial Year 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21 & 2021-22 of their respective websites and its links may be provided to me.
 4. I understand that your Organization is uploading value and details of items still being imported by them for the Financial Years 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21 & 2021-22. Weblinks of these websites may be provided to me
 5. Please provide me the contact details of the Official/Officials with their contact details including Name, Designation, Mobile, and Email i.d. who are responsible for implementation of the Policy Directive referred above in your Organization.
- 1.3 I request to kindly provide me the information and documents sought above referring my this application reference and date to my email within the prescribed time limit of the RTI Act 2005 or may be sent by post to my address above. ***In case the information is not available with you, my application may be forwarded to the concerned Public information Officers for providing the information to me directly under Section 6(3) of the RTI Act, with a copy endorsed to me, for my information.***

1. Please refer your RTI request reference no. LDA/RTI/1341/CPSE dated December 12, 2022 received by us on January 11, 2023. The information sought under the said request is given below:

- (i) Kindly provide the present day status of implementation of DIPP, Ministry of Commerce and Industry order dated 15th June 2017 by Cochin Shipyard Limited (CSL).

Answer

The DIPP order dated June 15, 2017 has been implemented in Cochin Shipyard Limited (CSL) in totality within the limits of our necessity to conduct business, as explained in paragraphs below.

- (a) All items being procured for our own use viz., capital and revenue procurement of machinery, consumables, uniforms and liveries, paints, oils and lubricants, miscellaneous items for administration etc., are sourced from local suppliers.
- (b) All items for use onboard ships under new construction and repair, except as listed at Para (c) and (d) below are sourced from local suppliers.
- (c) All proprietary items (for spare parts) are sourced from OEMs (as necessitated by nature of being proprietary). This is essential for the nature of conduct of our business, failing which CSL would not be able to obtain ship repair orders.
- (d) All 'OWNER nominated' equipment / machinery are sourced from OEMs (as nominated by OWNER). This is essential for the nature of conduct of our business, failing which CSL would not be able to obtain commercial ship building orders.
- (ii) Please provide value of indigenous procurement made by Cochin Shipyard Limited (CSL) in terms of the order referred above for the Financial Year 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22 and the total saving of Foreign Exchange made in the process by CSL.

Answer
