- e) The level gauges must be calibrated before supply to yard.
- f) Refer (175-MIS-005) for the preliminary arrangement of Level Gauges. The actual dimensions of the same will be given post order.

4. Magnetic Level Gauges

- a) The fuel oil and lube oil tank level gauges are to be of type approved. The type approval certificate shall be included in the offer.
- b) The magnetic level gauges must have two process connection at top and bottom sides. The size of process connection is to be as per DN25 PN10 EN1092-1 Flat Face standard.
- c) The level gauges should have valves with hand wheel for drain and vent connections. The extension height of these vent and drain valves must be as small as possible.
- d) The fuel oil tank level gauges should be suitable for withstanding high temperature and high pressure. The temperature range of application of system shall be approximately 5°C to 100°C.
- e) The material of construction shall be SS304 or higher.
- f) All level gauges shall be of mechanical type. There should be no electric power requirement for the items.

5. Reflex Level Gauges

- a) The reflex level gauges are preferably to be of type approved. The type approval certificate shall be included in the offer.
- b) All level gauges shall be of mechanical type. There should be no electric power requirement for the items.
- c) The reflex level gauges must have two process connection at top and bottom sides. The size of process connection is to be as per DN25 PN10 EN1092-1 Flat Face standard.
- d) The material of construction to be SS304 or higher.
- e) The reflex and tubular level gauges to be supplied with necessary isolation valves for connection with tank, drain and vent. The extension height of these vent and drain valves must be as small as possible.

6. Hydrostatic Level Gauges

- a) The material of construction to be min. SS316.
- b) The hydrostatic level gauges are preferably to be of type approved for marine duty. The type approval certificate shall be included in the offer.
- c) The hydrostatic level gauges shall be mechanical type.
- d) The level gauges to have a SS316 diaphragm and SS316 diaphragm sensor housing. The level gauge will be fitted at the bottom side of the tank.

- e) The hydrostatic liquid level gauge shall have a display (indicator gauge) mounted 1m to 3m away from the connection. The display shall be of analogue and suitable for fixing at bulkhead.
- f) The display unit and the level gauge to be connected using a PVC sheathed copper capillary tube. The actual length of the cable will be finalized post order.
- g) The mechanical tube between the level gauge between the level gauge and the display unit to be under vendor's scope of supply.

The name plate(s) and caution plate (s) shall be written in English indicated in SI unit. All items to be supplied along with the tally plates for identification. 




