- d) Contractor shall indicate details like PAN, GST details etc. required for processing payment. Payments will be made through NEFT/RTGS/Cheque mode and necessary details shall be furnished by the contractor.
- e) HCSL reserves the right for the deduction of taxes and duties as applicable from the bill or invoice.

Conditional rebates and discounts, incomplete/ambiguous offers are likely to be rejected.
- 18. Necessary Insurance Coverage for the contractor's materials / equipment / vehicle including Third Party liability and for the workmen (covering Workmen's Compensation Act) engaged by the Contractor are to be taken at his cost. If any accident/injury occurs to any other persons/public due to proven negligence/non-adherence to relevant safety and other precautions on the part of Contractor/it's employees, the contractor shall remain liable to pay necessary compensation and other expense, as decided by appropriate authorities.
- 19. The contract shall be on a principal-to-principal basis and it will not create any employer, employee relationship between HCSL and firm / its personnel.
- 20. The rates agreed upon as per the quotation remain firm and fixed and will not be changed till conclusion of contract including extended period if any.
- 21. HSE guidelines issued by HCSL from time to time shall be followed by the contractor.
- 22. During the evaluation of tender HCSL Officer-in-Charge may at his discretion ask the bidders for clarification in writing. Response for clarification shall be given in writing and no change in prices or substance of the bid shall be sought, offered or permitted. No post bid clarification on the initiative of the bidder will be entertained
- 23. HCSL reserves the right to terminate the work order at short notice in case the firm's performance is found not satisfactory with regard to the progress of work, quality, time factor, labour dispute with their workers, poor safety record and other violation of any contract conditions. No claim whatsoever will be entertained in this regard from the firm.

24. Force Majeure condition:

Should failure in performance of the contract or part thereof arise from war insurrection, restrain imposed by Government, Act of Legislature or other Statutory Authority or illegal strike, riot, legal lock-out, flood, fire, explosion, act of God or any inevitable or unforeseen event beyond human control which may be construed as reasonable ground for an extension of time, HCSL may allow such additional time as is mutually agreed, to be justified by the circumstances of the case. The occurrence/cessation of force majeure situation is to be informed with documentary evidence within 15 days from the date of occurrence/cessation.

25. Risk Purchase:

If the Contractor fails to commence the work as per the instruction of Officer in Charge or violate any of the terms and conditions of the purchase order, HCSL shall have the following rights.

- a) To cancel the order partially or fully with 15 days' notice and to forfeit the security deposit, if any.
- b) To impose tender holiday for the vendor for an appropriate period as decided by HCSL.
- c) To initiate alternate procurement action at the risk and cost of the supplier.
- d) This Risk Purchase clause is applicable only in the case of total order/contract value (excluding taxes and duties) is Rs.20 lakhs and above (or equivalent foreign currency).
- cases of value less than 20 lakhs will be addressed by serving appropriate caution/ warning notice to the firm.

26. Jurisdiction:

All questions, disputes or difference arising under, out of, or in connection with contracts shall be subjected to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts at Kolkata, India.
