- c. Bidder shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility issued by Govt. of India/ State govt./Public Sector Undertakings etc. The bidder shall not have been debarred / black listed by CSL or by any of the Public Sector Undertaking or Government department etc. The declaration of eligibility at Annexure VI shall be submitted in this regard.
- d. The bidding firm should have valid PAN and GSTIN and details of PAN / GST Registration Number and current valid Tax Clearance Certificate shall be submitted along with the offer.

The scope of work includes Safe Transportation of Turning Cradle with accessories and Welding Machines from Udupi Cochin Shipyard Limited, Hangarkate to Hooghly Cochin Shipyard Ltd, Howrah up to the entire satisfaction of HCSL, in accordance with the delivery schedule, HCSL - Terms and conditions in all respects.

- 1. Transportation Of Turning Cradle with accessories From UCSL, Malpe, Udupi to HCSL, Howrah by Road.
- 2. Transportation Of Welding Machines (Migatronic Sigma Select 400) From UCSL, Malpe, Udupi to HCSL, Howrah by Road. Adequate covering (from weather) should be provided by the contractor during the entire transportation period.
- 3. To ensure that all the materials that are to be transported should be in the best of the condition with no damage.
- **4.** Proper packing of loaded material by using rope and tarpaulin. Also, packing materials viz wedges, wooden pieces are to be arranged by the contractor.
- **5.** Vehicles should bear pollution control certificate and be in good roadworthy condition.
- **6.** Material receipt certificate signed by Hooghly Cochin Shipyard Limited (HCSL), West Bengal will be provided to HCSL for payment.
- 7. No extra charges shall be paid like Penalty, RTO fine, Railway blockade charge etc.
- **8.** The transporters shall be bound to report movement progresses of all consignments through electronic communication systems such as Mobile, Phone, e-mail, web based monitoring system or any other mode desired by HCSL at regular intervals.
- 9. The cradle with accessories and welding machines have to be delivered in HCSL with a maximum transit time of 07 days from UCSL.





1. 2. The Techno-commercial part alone will be opened initially on the due date and time of tender. The price part will be opened only after evaluation of the Techno commercial part. Bidders will be intimated the date of opening of the price part, whose techno- commercial bids are acceptable in due course.

Note:

- i. <u>Modification or alteration of the price bid format attached is strictly prohibited. Otherwise Bid will be liable for rejection.</u>
- ii. <u>In case Price bid is placed inadvertently in the Techno-Commercial Part or in case Price bid is not password</u> protected, Bid will be straightway rejected.
- Bidders can contact Officer-in-charge of the work which is indicated in the Tender Notice for any clarification before submitting the offer. If clarifications/details are not obtained before the offer is submitted, no claim on this account will be admitted.
- 4. The transporters engaged shall operate their vehicles entirely at their own risk and HCSL shall not be held responsible for any damage to the vehicle while on the company's/customer's work or when parked in or around the company's/ customer's or any other premises.
- 5. The Transporters should make their own arrangements for proper parking of their vehicles overnight during detention in company's/customer's premises.
- 6. The transporters shall ensure that all vehicles used for the transportation of consignments under transportation rate contracts are covered by a comprehensive insurance policy. Under no circumstance shall the company be liable to compensate them for any loss or damage that may be caused to the vehicles while engaged in the discharge of the transporter's obligations under this contract.
- 7. It shall be the responsibility of the transporter to provide at his cost trained and licensed personnel for running the vehicles.
- 8. The transporter shall ensure placing vehicles of suitable category, capacity (i.e. size and load) and quality. Overloading of the vehicles will not be permitted in any circumstances.
- 9. Proper loading and lashing of the consignments in most secured manner shall be done keeping in view extant government regulations and constraints en-route for safe transportation of consignments and its delivery to destination.

- 10. Transporters shall make aware concerned drivers/staff about the danger related to transportation of hazardous/ODC lifting, handling and tilting of such consignments.
- 11. Transporters shall ensure that the latest applicable Motor Vehicle Act 1989 (as amended up to date)/ Motor Vehicle Rule is strictly followed as applicable. Vehicles must carry up to date fitness, road permit, insurance and related documents/ certificates.
- 12. All drivers/concerned staff related to the transportation activities under this contract should be well aware about material safety, data sheet etc. and well conversant with the environmental impact arising from the specified activities pertaining to use of fuels, lube oils, its spillage and disposal of various harmful items used in automotive vehicles.
- 13. Transporters shall follow all necessary instructions relating to IS0-1400 I and IS0- 18001 obligations for environmental safety and occupational Health Safety.
- 14. The transporter shall arrange required permits from RTO or other concerned authorities and ensure compliance of any other legal and statutory formalities connected with the transportation of goods at his cost. HCSL doesn't take any responsibility in this regard.
- 15. The transporter shall get permission from Govt. of India, Ministry of Road Transport & High ways or from State Govt(s) or from local bodies necessitating such requirement relating to Motor Vehicles Act. The transporter will produce such approved documents requiring scrutiny accordingly, before the consignment is loaded.
- 16. Vehicle shall not carry any other consignment in the same vehicle en-route. Should such a case be found, appropriate action including disallowance of freight / recovery of damages shall be taken.
- 17. The transporter should ensure that vehicles placed have valid registration, insurance, perm it and fitness certificate.
- 18. All documents related with transportation, required to be shown at various check posts are collected by the transporter so that the consignments are not detained/delayed en-route on this account. Detention / delays on this account will be the transporter's responsibility.
- 19. All applicable taxes, duties, transportation, delivery at HCSL Nazirgunge Works etc. should be included in the rate quoted, unless specified otherwise. HCSL reserves the right for the deduction of taxes and duties as applicable from the bill or invoice.
- 20. Bidders to note that no advance payment will be made by HCSL against work order issued.
- 21. Bidders shall quote total amount in figures and in words. Corrections and additions if any must be attested/ duly signed by the bidder. In the case of error in multiplication/addition in amount calculated, the rate quoted will be considered as correct and the amount will be calculated accordingly. Conditional rebates & discounts, incomplete/ambiguous offers are likely to be rejected.
- 22. Bidder has to submit the price bid as mentioned in the format (Annexure-2) only other wise bid will be rejected. L1 Bidder will be evaluated based on the combined cost of all the SOQ including GST
- 23. If the contractor fails to commence the work, in time as per the terms in purchase order, HCSL shall have the following rights.
 - a) To terminate the contract within 15 days of notice.

- b) To initiate alternative arrangements at the risk and cost of the contractor.
- 24. **Jurisdiction:** Any disputes or differences arising under, out of, or in connection with the contract shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts at Kolkata, West Bengal, India.

25. Liquidated Damages

The progress of work will be monitored against the mutually agreed detailed schedule referred in this tender. Liquidated damages for delays in execution of the work envisaged as per this order, for any reason other than force majeure conditions, will be recovered at the rate of Two and half percent (2.5%) of the basic value of the delayed work per week or part thereof, subject to a maximum of ten (10) percent of the basic value of the delayed work.

26. Force majeure condition: Should failure in performance of the contract or part thereof arise from war insurrection, restrain imposed by Government, Act of Legislature or other Statutory Authority or illegal strike, riot, legal lock-out, flood, fire, explosion, act of God or any inevitable or unforeseen event beyond human control which may be construed as reasonable ground for an extension of time, HCSL may allow such additional time as is mutually agreed to be justified by the circumstances of the case. The occurrence/cessation of force majeure situation is to be informed with documentary evidence within 15 days from the date of occurrence/cessation.

2. TECHNO-COMMERCIAL PART SHOULD CONTAIN FOLLOWING DETAILS

- a. Stamped and signed copy of all pages of **tender document and corrigenda (if any)** with all supporting document.
- b. Technical Specification as per Annexure 1.
- c. Signed Copy of unpriced Price bid (Annexure 2) (Price bid without price & with percentage of taxes & duties and details like quoted/Nil/included need to be mentioned for each line item.)

I. MSME/NSIC BENEFITS:

A. The following benefits are extended for all the firms who are registered with district industries center and come under the category of Micro and Small Enterprises holding a valid Entrepreneurs Memorandum (EM) part ii certificate or Udyog Aadhaar Certificate. However, in order to avail the benefits as per public procurement policy for MSME's orders, 2012, all MSE bidders are required to declare their Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum (UAM) number in Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) compulsorily.

- Payment of earnest money deposit (EMD) is exempted.
