4. **Guarantee/Warranty**

12 months from date of delivery (Guarantee certificate should be submitted along with the supply). The equipment shall have guaranteed performance for rugged site conditions since equipment is intended for use on uneven surfaces.

5. Period of Delivery:

- a) The item against the purchase order shall be delivered within 30 days rom the date of acceptance of purchase order.
- b) In the event of delay occurred due to genuine reasons not accountable to the contractor, these days will be excluded from the allotted completion duration, at the discretion of CSL.

- 2. Location of delivery: Cochin Shipyard Limited, CSL-Kolkata Ship Repair Unit, Gate No.9, Netaji Subhas Dock, Circular Garden Reach Road, Kolkata 24.
- 3. Validity: The bid should remain valid till 120 days from the last date of submission of the bids.
- 4. L1 will be arrived based on the lowest total amount quoted for all items excluding GST.
- 5. Bidders shall quote total amount in figures and in words. Corrections and additions, if any, must be attested / duly signed by the bidder. In the case of error in multiplication / addition in amount calculated, the unit rate quoted will be considered as correct and the amount will be calculated accordingly. Conditional rebates & discounts, incomplete / ambiguous offers are likely to be rejected.
- 6. GST / Duties, if any, payable extra is to be indicated in the price part for single bid and in techno-commercial part for two bids.
- 7. The Bidder shall submit the Electronic Payment Mandate Form, as per Enclosure 1 in their letter head duly signed by the respective authorized representative of the Bank with a cancelled cheque along with the Offer.
- 8. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand Only) shall be remitted in the form of Demand Draft from Scheduled Banks in favour of "Cochin Shipyard Limited" payable at Kochi. Cash, Cheque, Bank Guarantee, Postal orders etc., are not acceptable. No interest will be payable to EMD. EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be returned only after awarding the work to the successful bidder.
- 9. Earnest Money Deposit remitted by the successful bidder shall be adjusted against the Security Deposit or refunded separately as decided by CSL.

The Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) may be forfeited if :-

- i. The bidder withdraws, amends, impairs, or derogates from the tender or agreed conditions in any respect within the period of validity of their offer.
- ii. Non-acceptance of work order.
- iii. Bidder after accepting the work order fails to provide services.
- 10. Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) as defined in MSE Procurement Policy issued by Department of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) or are registered with the Central Purchase Organisation or the concerned Ministry or Department are exempted from submission of EMD.
- 11. Payment Terms:
 - a) 100% payment after completion of supply of all items as per the Purchase Order and final acceptance by Officer In-Charge after necessary deduction including Security

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Deposit, if any.

- b) Contractor shall indicate details like PAN, GST details etc. required for processing payment. Payments will be made through NEFT/RTGS/Cheque mode and necessary details shall be furnished by the contractor. CSL reserves the right for the deduction of taxes and duties as applicable from the bill or invoice.
- c) The invoice is to be raised on Deputy General Manager (CKSRU), Cochin Shipyard Limited, CSL-Kolkata Ship Repair Unit (CKSRU), Dry Dock Office Building, Gate No.09, Netaji Subhas Dock, Circular Garden Reach Road, Kolkata 24.
- d) GST No. of CSL-Kolkata Ship Repair Unit is 19AAACC6905B1Z1.
- e) Payment will be released tentatively within 30 days from the date of submission of bill duly certified by the authorized CSL representative at Kolkata. Delay of accepted bills will lead to delay in processing of payment.
- 12. Bidders to note that no advance payment will be made by CSL against work order issued.
- 13. Performance Security:
 - a) The contractor shall remit a security deposit of 5% of the total order value (including taxes, duties) in the form of demand draft drawn in favour of Cochin Shipyard Ltd towards the satisfactory performance of the contract. Alternatively, a Bank Guarantee equivalent to above % of the total order value (including taxes, duties) as per CSL format from a Scheduled Indian bank is to be submitted.
 - b) The Bank Guarantee/DD as above should be initially valid till 30 days after completion of entire work in terms of SD and later revalidated (within the validity of initial BG) to cover the guarantee period plus 60 days. Fixed Deposit Receipt (for equivalent amount of Security Deposit/WBG required as per tender) in lieu of bank guarantee is also acceptable. Fixed Deposit Receipt shall be in the name of contractor with lien marked in favour of Cochin Shipyard Limited, Kochi.
 - c) Performance Security to be submitted within 2 weeks of receipt of order from CSL.
- 14. Guarantee: The goods supplied shall be guaranteed for satisfactory performance for 12 months wherever applicable from the date of delivery against faulty design, defective materials and bad workmanship. Guarantee certificate should be submitted by the contractor along with the supply. Supplier should supply and install free of cost immediately any part found to be defective for the above reasons within the guarantee period.
- 15. Liquidated Damages: In case of any delay in supply of ordered materials beyond the stipulated time period, the contractor has to pay Liquidated Damage (LD) a sum equivalent to ½% (half percentage) per week or part of the week of the order value subjected to maximum of 10% of the order value.
- 16. Transportation clause (to and fro): To and fro transportation of all materials is under the scope of bidder.
- 17. Language: All documents, instructions, catalogues, brochures, pamphlets, design data, norms and calculations, drawings, operation, maintenance and safety manuals, reports,

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labels on deliveries and any other data shall be in English language.

- 18. All applicable taxes, duties, transportation and insurance etc. should be included in the rate quoted, unless specified otherwise. CSL reserves the right for the deduction of taxes and duties as applicable from the bill or invoice.
- 17. MSEs, Start-ups, Local Suppliers (Make in India), MSME firms and Start-ups will be eligible for various relaxations in pre-qualification criteria and other benefits as per the orders promulgated by Government of India. Bidders are advised to refer the details of various benefits and relaxation in pre-qualification criteria as published at CSL website (www.cochinshipyard.in) under the Tenders tab for further reference.
- 18. Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) as defined in MSE Procurement Policy issued by Department of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) or are registered with the Central Purchase Organisation or the concerned Ministry or Department are exempted from submission of EMD & Tender cost.

19. Restrictions under Rule 144 (Xi) of the General Financial Rules (GFRS), 2017

a) Certificate shall be submitted by the bidders as per the below format along with their offer, stating compliance with office order OM No. 6/18/2019-PPD dated 23rd July 2020 (as amended from time to time shall be applicable) regarding restrictions under rule 144 (ix) of the General Financial Rules (GFRs).

"I have read the clause regarding restrictions on procurement from as bidder of a country which shares a land border with India and on sub- contracting to contractors from such countries; I certify that this bidder is not from such a country or, if from such a country, has been registered with the competent authority and will not sub contract any work to a contractor from such countries unless such contractor is registered with competent authority. I hereby certify that this bidder fulfills all requirement in this regard and is eligible to be considered"

Where applicable, evidence of valid registration by the competent authority shall be attached.

b) Any bidder from a country, which shares a land border with India, will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority. In works contracts, including turkey contracts, contractors shall not be allowed to sub contract works to any contractor from a country which shares a land border with India unless such contractor is registered with Competent authority. Relevant certificate to be submitted by bidder from a country which shares land border with India except for bidders to which Govt. of India has extended lines of Credit or in which Govt. of India has development projects, along with the offer as proof of registration with competent authority, failing which the offer will not be considered. A certificate is to be submitted by the bidder for compliance with the order referred above long with tender documents for consideration of offer (Wordings are as per Clause below). If such certificate given by a bidder whose bid is accepted is found to

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be false, this would be a ground for immediate termination and further legal action in accordance with law.

- Registration should be valid at the time of submission of bids and at the time of acceptance of bids. In respect of supply otherwise than by tender, registration should be valid at the time of placement of order. If the bidder is validly registered at the time of acceptance /order placement, registration shall not be a relevant consideration during contract execution.
- d) The competent authority for the purpose of registration under the order shall be Registration committee constituted by the Department of Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT). Details of the committee and procedure for registration and restrictions shall be as per Ann. I of the Order -Public Procurement no 1 dt 23.7.2020 issued by Ministry of Finance, department of Expenditure.
- e) "Bidder" (including the term 'tenderers', 'consultant' or 'Service provider' in certain contexts) means any person or firm or company, including any member of a consortium or joint venture (that is an association of several persons, or firms or companies), every artificial juridical person not falling in any of the descriptions of bidders stated hereinbefore, including any agency branch or office controlled by such person, participating in a procurement process.
- f) "Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India" for the purpose of this Order means:-
 - I. An entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
 - A subsidiary of an entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
 - III. An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
 - IV. An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country; or
 - v. An Indian (or other) agent of such an entity; or
 - VI. A natural person who is a citizen of such a country; or
 - VII. A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture falls under any of the above
- g) The beneficial owner for the purpose above will be as under:
 - In case of a company or Limited Liability Partnership, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has a controlling ownership interest or who exercises control through other means.

Explanation-

i. "Controlling ownership interest" means ownership of or entitlement to more

- than twenty-five per cent of shares or capital or profits of the company.
- ii. "Control" shall include the right to appoint majority of the directors or to control the management or policy decisions including by virtue of their shareholding or management rights or shareholders agreements or voting agreements.
- II. In case of a partnership firm, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s) who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more judicial person has ownership of entitlement to more than fifteen percent of capital or profits of the partnership.
- III. In case of an unincorporated association or body of individuals, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of or entitlement to more than fifteen percent of the property or capital or profits of such association or body of individuals,
- IV. Where no natural person is identified under (1) or (2) or (3) above, the beneficial owner is the relevant natural person who holds the position of senior managing official;
- V. In case of trust, the identification of beneficial owner(s) shall include identification of the author of the trust, the trustee, the beneficiaries with fifteen percent or more interest in the trust and any other natural person exercising ultimate effective control over the trust through a chain of control or ownership.
- h) An Agent is a person employed to do any act for another, or to represent another in dealings with third person.
- The successful bidder shall not be allowed to sub-contract works to any contractor from a country, which shares a land border with India unless such contractor is registered with the Competent Authority.
- 20. Indian Agent: Cochin Shipyard Ltd. is a fully owned Govt. of India Enterprise and prefers to deal directly with the supplier. However, if the supplier appoints an Indian Agent to deal with Cochin Shipyard Ltd., the commission payable by the supplier to such an agency shall be intimated. The Indian agent shall be enlisted with Director General of Supplies and Disposals under the compulsory registration scheme of Ministry of Finance. "If manufacturer's effect supplied through Agents only, authorization in writing from manufacturers in favor of the Agent for supply to CKSRU/CSL shall be furnished. If Indian Agent submit offers on behalf of Foreign manufacturers, copy of the Agency Agreement between them and their mutual interest in the basis to be furnished. In case where an Agent participates in a tender on behalf of a foreign manufacturer with specific authorization from the manufacturer, he should not quote on behalf of another foreign manufacturer along with the first manufacturer in a subsequent/ parallel tender for the same item. In other words, one Agent cannot represent two suppliers or quote on their behalf in a particular tender."
- 21. Risk Purchase: If the supplier fails to supply the items ordered with in the delivery date or

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violate any of the terms and conditions of the purchase order; CKSRU/CSL shall have the following rights.

- a) To terminate the contract with 15 days' notice forfeiting the security deposit.
- b) To initiate alternate procurement action at the risk and cost of the supplier.
- 22. Force Majeure Condition: Should failure in performance of the contract or part there of arise from war insurrection, restrain imposed by Government, Act of Legislature of other statutory Authority or illegal strike (event like local strike/ harthal etc in the yard, state or national), riot legal lock out, flood, fire, explosion, Act of God of any inevitable or unforeseen beyond human capacity which may be constructed as reasonable ground for an extension of time. CSL may allow such additional time as is mutually agreed, to be justified by the circumstances of the case. The occurrence/ cessation of force majeure situation is to be informed with documentary evidence within 15 days from the date of occurrence or cessation.

23. Tax Elements:

- a) The tax rate of the Goods and Services would be as per the Government of India published G-ST rate schedule for goods & services. The rates have been mapped with HSN & SAC in the rate notification issued by the government. The rate schedule should be referred to identify the applicable rate.
- b) Permanent Account Number (PAN) obtained from Income Tax Department should be mentioned in the invoice for inclusion of PAN in the TDS returns filed by CSL.
- c) GST ld should be mentioned.
- d) The invoices should be as per the provisions of GST law. The invoices should mandatorily contain the HSN code/SAC and GSTIN number along with other particulars. The GST charged (CGST&SGST or IGST) should be separately indicated in the invoice.
- e) Tax inclusive invoices will not be accepted.
- f) All correction/rectification in the invoices should be done through Debit note / Credit note only.
- 24. All statutory requirements are to be followed by the contractor. Packing material used, if any, should be eco-friendly.
- 25. Port entry permit: Since the item is to be delivered inside the Port area, the contractor shall abide by all rules and regulations of the docks in force from time to time as applicable. The contractor is required to obtain required permit / RFID card issued by SMP to enter the CKSRU premises. The necessary recommendations will be issued by CKSRU to permit the contractor to take the materials / equipment / vehicle inside the dock area for the execution of the work.
- 26. It is clarified that the Contractor cannot go for arbitration for any disputes arising out of the agreement related to this contract work. Cochin Shipyard Ltd. has a Grievance Redressal Cell and all disputes shall be attended by CSL Grievance Redressal Cell. All questions, disputes difference or differences arising under, out of, or in connection with

- the contract after hearing by Cochin Shipyard Ltd Grievance Redressal Committee shall be subject to Indian Laws in force and at the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts at Kochi.
- 27. All necessary test certificates, warranty documents of exhaust fan, roof mounted fan etc. need to be supplied along with product.
- 28. Bidder shall send drawings and photographs of available containers (from all sides) to buyer along with the technical bid.
- 29. Quoted GST percentage should be mentioned in the technical bid.
- 30. Delivery: All the items as per the scope of work shall be delivered as per the tender conditions within 30 days from the date of acceptance of Work Order.

- 33. Photographs of available product: Drawings and photographs of available containers (from all sides) shall be submitted along with the bid.
- 34. Products supplied shall be nontoxic and harmless to health. In the case of toxic materials, Material Safety Data Sheet may be furnished along with the material.
- 35. Jurisdiction: Any disputes or differences arising under, out of, or in connection with the contract shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts at Ernakulam, Kerala, India.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR TWO BID SYSTEMS

1. Mode of Submission of Tenders

Tenders should be submitted in two separate sealed covers superscribed in capital letters as PART-I "TECHNO- COMMERCIAL" & PART-II "PRICE" indicating the tender number, due date and name & address of the Bidder.

- 2. Techno-Commercial Part should contain following details
 - a) Documents for minimum eligibility criteria
 - b) Other conditions, if any
 - c) Copy of unpriced price bid (Price bid without price & with percentage of taxes & duties and details like quoted/Nil/Included need to be mentioned for each line item)
 - d) Complete set of tender documents duly signed and sealed on all pages as a token of acceptance
- 3. Price Part should contain following details
 - a) Duly filled price bid as per the tender document.
 - b) The quoted rate shall include rate for material, transportation, loading etc. to deliver the items to the location as mentioned in the tender document.
