TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION FOR HYDRANT VALVES

1. SCOPE OF SUPPLY:

1.1 This document indents for the supply of MMD/CLASS Approved Valves.

2. QUANTITY:

- 2.1 As per the Quantity Table in Annexure-1.
- 2.2 Valve quantity indicated above is for only one (1) vessel. The total requirement is to be considered for Four (04) vessels. The quantity may increase/decrease slightly based on the drawing approval & amendment.

3. QUANTITY:

The vessels shall be built under the following flag and classifications:

Flag : India

Classification : Indian Register of Shipping.

AGNI 1 (2400 m3/hour)

Type : "Indian Coastal Vessel"

4. CONDITIONS OF SUPPLY:

- 4.1 The offer should be complete with all relevant details such as detailed technical specifications, material specifications, overall dimensions, storage/ preservation details etc.
- 4.2 All valves should be suitable for marine applications. The material of construction of valves should be suitable for fluid handled and as per class requirements. The body material of valves is mentioned in Annexure-1.
- 4.3 All flanged valves should have flanges at both ends of standard as per EN1092-1 Type 01 Flat Face. In case of any deviation with this standard, the same should be indicated in the offer.
- 4.4 All threaded valves should be as per ISO standard. In case of any deviation with this standard, the same should be indicated in the offer.
- 4.5 The minimum hydraulic inspection of the valves shall be based on the PN rating mentioned.

4.6 Hydrant valves

Marine bronze fire hydrant valve with rising stem, screwed and secured bonnet, angled hose connection to be supplied. The hose connection shall be provided with John Morris instantaneous female coupling ends with twin twist lock.

- 4.7 All valves should be approved by MMD/IRS.
- 4.8 The face to face and center to face dimensions of valves shall be followed as per EN558 standard. In case of any deviation with this standard shall be mentioned in the technical offer.
- 4.9 All Valve testing shall comply to EN12266-1 Standard. In case of any deviation with this standard shall be mentioned in the technical offer.
- 4.10 The manufacturer's test certificate also to be provided for each consignment of material. All items shall be inspected by Hooghly Cochin Shipyard's representative, or a third party authorized by Hooghly Cochin shipyard Limited.
- 4.11 In case of any deviation with these conditions of supply, the same should be clearly indicated in the offer.



5. Guarantee

The items supplied shall be guaranteed against defective design, material and workmanship and under performance till, for a period as mentioned in commercial terms and conditions. Guarantee of the equipment shall be as per commercial terms and conditions.

General Remarks

a) Tally Plate

Identification markings/ tally plate to be provided showing the type of valve, material, nominal bore, pressure rating, test pressure and manufacturing process as applicable and as per manufacturer's standard. The details should be clearly visible and indicated in English and in SI unit.

HCSL will advise the identification marking/tally plate description at later stage. Vendor to request HCSL for details before valve manufacturing starts/supply.

b) Preservation

- i) Each valve shall be cleaned, prepared & suitably protected for dispatch in such a way so as to prevent ingress of moisture and contamination during transportation & storage.
- ii) The machined surface of fittings is to be suitably protected against mechanical damage during shipment & storage.

8. Compliance

The vendor should comply all the points mentioned in this document. Deviations from the Technical specification shall be specifically indicated.
