


Turnover (Rs Crs) & EBITDA Margins(%)



New Dry Dock Project

- Dock Size: 310m x 75/60m x 13m (Stepped Dry Dock)
- Design Life: 100 Years
- Draught of vessel upto 9.5 m
- 600 T , 75 T and 40T Cranes
- Largest dry dock in India
- Suitable for LNG vessels, Aircraft Carriers, Jack-up Rigs, Drill ships, Large Tankers & Merchant vessels.



Installation & commissioning of 600T Gantry Crane is progressing. The New Dry Dock is expected to be fully operational after completion of above work by 31 Oct 2024.



Total Project Cost	Rs. 1,799.00 Cr.
Expenditure incurred till date	Rs. 1,344.59 Cr.

Civil works such as dock floor, dock wall, caisson gate, pump house, sub-stations etc. are fully completed and the New Dry Dock was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on January 17, 2024.






