

High agri-commodity prices buoy kharif crop prospects

Seed makers see strong demand for cotton, maize hybrids

Bengaluru, May 20

The hybrid seeds trade is bullish on prospects in the upcoming kharif season as higher commodity prices and forecast of a normal monsoon have triggered demand from farmers for seeds of crops such as cotton, maize and soyabean among others in parts of southern and central India.

"We are seeing extremely good demand for cotton seeds in Gujarat, central India, Karnataka and South," said Ankur Aggarwal, CEO, Crystal Crop Protection Ltd, which acquired Bayer's seed brands in India last year.

The purchase of cottonseeds by farmers is aggressive. Karnataka and Gujarat have done well, while cotton seeds sales in

Maharashtra have begun. "We believe that aggressive purchase by farmers is a sign of increased acreages of cotton," Aggarwal said adding the company expects to see a minimum growth of 10 per cent.

Beneficial summer rains

The summer rains have been good across South India and as per the latest figures the rainfall was 64 per cent more than normal during the season from March 1 till May 18, while the precipitation in the region was 173 per cent more during the week ended May 18. For the country as a whole, rainfall was up 122 per cent during the week ended May 18.

Shardul Sheth, co-founder and CEO, AgroStar, said cotton farmers have been purchasing seeds three weeks in advance. "We are seeing a strong trend in Gujarat, Rajasthan, Maharashtra for cot-



tonseeds, Uttar Pradesh for paddy and Madhya Pradesh for soyabean seeds. We are seeing a fantastic uptake in the purchase of seeds," Sheth said.

Positive sentiment

Crystal Crop's Aggarwal said the overall sentiment is looking positive as the IMD forecast is good for rains till July. "The best part is commodity prices are extremely supportive. Prices of horticulture produce, chilli, cotton, soyabean, paddy, wheat, pulses are all good. There is no reason that farmers' investment will be a problem. If

we have a decent spread of monsoon, we should have good agriculture this year," Aggarwal added.

In North India, the cotton planting season is the last phase and the overall acreage is likely to exceed last year's levels. M Ramasami, Founder of Rasi Seeds Pvt Ltd, the largest selling hybrid cottonseed in the country, said the sentiment is good and there is likely to be some increase in the area in Central and South. In Gujarat, there is some improvement and sales will start from next month in other regions. "We see some movement happening in MP and South Rajasthan. Sales will pick up in June first week," he said.

Sateesh Nukala, CEO and co-founder, BigHaat, said the demand is looking strong this year based on our data and acreages are going to be up given the cotton prices are at a lifetime high.

Castorseed crop size trimmed to 16.94 lakh tonnes on low yields

Crop size pared in key growing States of Gujarat and Rajasthan

India's castorseed crop for the 2021-22 season is estimated at 16.94 lakh tonnes — 62,000 tonnes lower than last year's estimated output of 17.56 lakh tonnes (lt).

Trade body Solvent Extractors' Association of India (SEA), in its final round of crop survey, trimmed the crop estimate by 52,000 tonnes from its earlier projection (in April 2022) of 17.46 lt.

The reduction in crop size is attributed to a nearly three per cent dip in all-India yield to 2,088 kg/ha from 2,152 estimated last month.

Gujarat, the No 1 grower, is estimated to have castorseed output of 14.55 lt against 14.94 lt last year. A downward revision of

49,000 tonnes has been made to the State's castorseed crop size.

The crop estimate for Rajasthan is 1.94 lt, lower by about 4,000 tonnes than the previous estimate. The State's castorseed output was 2.24 lakh tonnes last year.

The SEA survey, conducted by AgriWatch, reported no changes to the crop estimates for Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

Gujarat, Rajasthan hit

While the maximum drop in crop is expected in Gujarat, the survey findings reveal that after the fourth round of field survey, the estimated average yield for 2021-22 is revised downward to 2,220 kg/ha against the first estimate of 2,371 kg/ha, a dip of six per cent. "Major decline from



previous estimated yield is reported in Surendranagar, Ahmedabad and Gandhinagar. It is mainly due to delayed sowing and higher temperature during March-April," said the survey findings explaining the dip in estimated crop size for Gujarat. Also, for Rajasthan, the dip in output is attributed to change in weather, hot winds and higher temperature.

Total all-India area under

castorseed cultivation for the year 2021-22 is considered at 8.11 lakh hectares, against the estimated 8.26 lakh hectares in 2020-21.

Castorseed prices quoted at ₹7,553 per quintal at spot markets in Deesa in north Gujarat. Prices on NCDEX for May contract quoted at ₹7,450. Spot prices have gained ₹405 or about four per cent in past month from ₹7,152 per quintal.

IG International has been in the fruit business for over 50 years and its augmented seamless supply chain with a well-connected overseas procurement network enables it to import best-of-breed fruits from 22 different countries.

Tarun Arora, Director of Finance and Operations of IG International, said, "We are working on the topmost rootstocks for our climatic conditions. This will result in higher yields for existing crops."

Shiv Kant Shukla, who heads the Plant Tissue Culture Programme (PTCP) of BCIL, said the tissue culture raised rootstock will transform the agriculture landscape, particularly in northern and north-eastern regions.

REVOKING PALM OIL EXPORT BAN

Indonesia to fix quota for domestic cooking oil supply

Exporters will have to meet obligation to supply a specific volume to domestic market

Indonesia will revoke its ban on exports of crude palm oil (CPO) and refined, bleached, deodorised (RBD) palm oil from May 23 (Monday) as scheduled, but with a rider.

Indonesian Economy Minister Airlangga Hartarto said on Friday that the Joko Widodo government will impose a domestic market obligation (DMO) on palm oil, which requires producers to supply a portion of their production to the local markets.

On Thursday (May 19), while announcing that his government would revoke the ban from May 23, Widodo said his country had ample palm oil supplies to ensure the supply of cooking oil to the domestic consumers.

Abdul Hameed, Director-Sales, Manzoor Trading in Lahore, Pakistan, told *Business-*

Line that Indonesia's DMO policy will be to ensure that at least 10 million tonnes will be supplied to ensure cooking oil to the country's vulnerable citizens.

Hameed said Indonesia planned to open at least 10,000 outlets to sell cooking oil at discount. The move follows the Widodo government's failure to reduce cooking oil prices to 14,000 rupiah (₹74) when it imposed the ban on April 28.

Though Hartarto said the DMO policy would be implemented while revoking the ban, he did not specify the percentage of production that a unit will have to meet under it.

Earlier obligations

"The trade ministry will determine the size of the DMO that must be met by each producer and the mechanism to produce and distribute cooking oil to the

communities," he said.

In addition, Indonesia's food procurement agency, Bulog, will be asked to build a cooking oil buffer stock, he said.

Earlier, palm oil producers were required to supply 20 per cent of their export volumes as part of DMO. Later, the percentage was increased to 30 per cent.

The announcement on DMO pushed up palm oil prices on Friday by over 0.5 per cent on the

Bursa Malaysia Derivatives market. Rates increased by 42 Malaysian ringgits (MYR) for the July contracts to 6,338 MYR and 47 MYR to 6,119 MYR for August contracts.

Palm oil prices increased by nearly four per cent initially soon after the announcement, before finding some stability at the lower level. The rise was in view of the trade considering it as some sort of reversal of Thursday's announcement revoking the ban.

Helping growers

Hameed said the Indonesian government has also come forward to help oil palm growers by guaranteeing palm fresh fruit bunches (FFB) purchase at good prices. He said Indonesia's move had come in the wake of Malaysia making headway in the export market after the ban. He pointed to the latest data from Amspec Group, which showed Malaysian palm oil exports increasing by 30 per cent during May 1-20 to 7,94,527 tonnes

against 6,10,728 tonnes during April 1-20. Indonesia, besides losing its market share due to the ban, also earned the wrath of oil palm growers and domestic producers. The ban resulted in farmers not harvesting FFB from their plantations. Domestic oil producers, too, cut their purchases as their storage tanks began to overflow with palm oil.

Relief for India

For India, the revoking of the ban will provide some relief from the skyrocketing inflation and soaring cooking oil prices. India imports about 8.5 million tonnes of palm oil, including RBD palmolein.

Currently, prices are \$1,735 C&F Mumbai for RBD palmolein, \$1,780 for CPO, \$1,830 for degummed soyabean oil and \$2,150 for sunflower oil. The all-India average retail price of palm oil is ₹158.06, while soyabean oil is ruling at ₹169.55. Sunflower is ruling at ₹191.89, groundnut at ₹187.1 and mustard oil at ₹185.08.

Heat wave conditions may wane under influence of monsoon, western disturbances

Thiruvananthapuram, May 20

Heat wave conditions over the country will abate from Saturday under the combined influence of monsoon making steady progress in the Arabian Sea and the Bay of Bengal and cooler western disturbances resuming their itinerary across the plains of North-West India and East India into the next week.

India Meteorological Department (IMD) said on Friday the monsoon has advanced into parts of south Arabian Sea and southern parts of Maldives on the Arabian Sea side and into more parts of south and east-central Bay of Bengal.

Pre-monsoon rain

Over the Bay, the monsoon flows are rallying around a depression off the Myanmar coast, after Thursday's low-pressure area underwent intensification twice over in the

space of 24 hours. A cyclonic circulation lies over south interior Karnataka and a North-South trough runs across Central and Peninsular India, both pre-monsoon systems.

They will combine to cause widespread light to moderate rainfall with thunderstorms, lightning and gusty winds over Kerala and Mahe during the next five days and over

rainfall trend may relent over South Peninsula from Saturday as the rain-driving pre-monsoon systems die out as they should, to give way for the real monsoon. Meanwhile, a wet spell will unfold over North-West and East India with thunderstorms gaining intensity from Sunday to Tuesday.

Western disturbances

This spell will be engineered by successive western disturbances travelling from North-West to South-East across North-West India into East and North-East India, rolling down a trough under which thunderstorms will breed.

Scattered to fairly widespread light to moderate rainfall with isolated thunderstorms, lightning and gusty winds are likely over the hills of North-West India while hailstorms may strike Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand.

Tur procurement in Gujarat crosses ₹104 crore

Procurement agencies in Gujarat have purchased 16,480 tonnes of tur (pigeon peas) worth ₹104 crore from as many as 8,617 farmers in the State.

The Gujarat government on Friday informed that 18,535 farmers have registered to participate in tur procurement under the Centre's price support scheme (PSS). The Centre has fixed the minimum support price (MSP) for tur at ₹6,300 per quintal for 2021-22.

The procurement under PSS had commenced in Gujarat from February 15 through the nodal agency Gujcomasol, under which total 8,617 farmers have participated.

Orthodox tea prices gain at Kochi auctions; Sri Lanka sales resume

Kochi, May 20

Buyers' participation for the Sri Lankan tea auction resumed on a muted note this week after the trading was cancelled last week.

As per reports, there was reluctance on the part of Sri Lankan buyers to participate in the auctions and their low turnout was because of the ongoing financial crisis in that country, a top official in a leading tea manufacturing company in Kochi told *BusinessLine*. Nobody wants to buy tea and stock in these times of uncertainties, he said.

It is expected to take a couple of months for the government to come out with



some drastic economic measures for business revival.

South India to benefit

Till then, the traders' participation and the demand are likely to be subdued, he said adding that South Indian orthodox teas have started benefiting out of the crisis by receiving some orders and more firm enquiries from exporters.

Meanwhile, the average

price realisation in orthodox leaf in Kochi auctions was up by ₹3 to ₹162 with active participation of exporters to CIS and West Asian countries. The quantity offered in sale 20 was 2,81,678 kg with 80 per cent being sold. The market for select best Nilgiri whole leaf and broken was firm to dearer.

However, CTC dust price was lower by ₹2 to ₹129 mainly on the back of good arrivals of the crop. The market for good liquoring teas was lower by ₹3-5 per kg, especially for high-priced teas. All blenders together absorbed 70 per cent of the offered quantity of 11,27,847 kg. There was a subdued demand from loose tea traders.

अनियमितताओं का पता लगाने के लिए जांच का निर्देश दिया। न्यायमूर्ति सिन्हा ने निर्देश दिया कि मामले की जांच सीबीआइ के क्षेत्रीय प्रमुख की कड़ी निगरानी में की जाएगी।

अदालत ने सीबीआइ को हाई कोर्ट के महापंजीयक को 20 जून तक सीलबंद लिफाफे में जांच रिपोर्ट सौंपने का निर्देश दिया।

पत्नी की चाकू मार कर हत्या

बरेली, 20 मई (जनसत्ता)।

थाना प्रेम नगर क्षेत्र में एक महिला की उसके पति ने अपने एक साथी के साथ मिलकर सड़क पर सरेंआम चाकू से गोदकर हत्या कर दी। नगर पुलिस अधीक्षक रविंद्र कुमार ने बताया कि मृतका की मां की ओर से दी गई तहरीर पर थाना पुलिस ने मुकदमा दर्ज कर आरोपी की तलाश शुरू कर दी है।

थाना प्रेमनगर क्षेत्र में बानखाना की रहने वाली निशी कश्यप का विवाह लगभग दो साल पहले पड़ोस में ही रहने वाले विकास सक्सेना से हुआ था। पुलिस को आस पास के लोगों ने बताया कि पति-पत्नी में आर्थिक कारणों से अक्सर आपस में झगडा होता रहता था। अभी हाल ही में विकास से झगडा होने पर निशी अपनी नौ महीने की बेटी को लेकर मायके में रहने लगी थी।

वह अपनी बेटी के लिए दूध लेने के लिए घर से बाहर गुरुवार को निकली थी। रास्ते में उसके पति ने अपने एक साथी शिवम उर्फ कमांडों के साथ मिलकर निशी पर चाकूओं से हमला कर दिया जिससे वह लहलुहान होकर वहीं गिर गई। आस पास के लोगों की भीड़ जमा होने पर हमलावर विकास और उसका साथी दोनों फरार हो गए। मृतका के भाई ने उसे जिला अस्पताल पहुंचाया जहां डाक्टरों ने उसे मृत घोषित कर दिया।

पुलिस ने शव को बरामद कर पोस्टमार्टम के लिए भेजा है। मृतका की मां दुर्गा कश्यप की ओर से दी गई तहरीर पर थाना प्रेम नगर की पुलिस ने मुकदमा दर्ज कर लिया है। नगर पुलिस अधीक्षक रविंद्र कुमार ने बताया कि फरार आरोपियों की तलाश में कई स्थानों पर दबिश डाली गई लेकिन अब तक उनका सुराग नहीं मिला है।

'राज ठाकरे ने अयोध्या आने का मौका गंवाया'

गाँडा, 20 मई (जनसत्ता)।

कैसरगंज संसदीय सीट से भारतीय जनता पार्टी (भाजपा) के सांसद वृजभूषण शरण सिंह ने शुक्रवार को कहा कि मनसे प्रमुख राज ठाकरे के पास माफी मांग कर अयोध्या आने का एक अच्छा अवसर था, लेकिन वह इससे चूक गए।

सिंह ने महाराष्ट्र नवनिर्माण सेना (मनसे) प्रमुख राज ठाकरे की आगामी पांच जून को प्रस्तावित अयोध्या यात्रा स्थगित किए जाने पर प्रतिक्रिया व्यक्त करते हुए पत्रकारों से कहा कि उनके पास माफी मांग कर अयोध्या आने का एक अच्छा अवसर था, लेकिन वह इस

अवसर से चूक गए। ठाकरे ने शुक्रवार को घोषणा की कि पांच जून का उनका अयोध्या दौरा रद्द कर दिया गया है। सांसद ने ठाकरे के अयोध्या दौरे का विरोध किया था और आगाह किया था कि उन्हें तब तक उत्तर प्रदेश के इस शहर में प्रवेश नहीं करने दिया जाएगा, जब तक कि वह पूर्व में उत्तर भारतीयों का 'अपमान' करने के लिए सार्वजनिक तौर पर माफी नहीं मांग लेते हैं। सांसद ने कहा कि अगर राज ठाकरे ने संतो, उत्तर प्रदेश के मुख्यमंत्री योगी आदित्यनाथ और प्रधानमंत्री नरेंद्र मोदी से माफी मांगी होती तो लोगों का गुस्सा शांत हो जाता। उन्होंने कहा, 'लेकिन ठाकरे ने माफी नहीं मांगी। इसलिए मैंने तय

किया है कि उनकी यात्रा को लेकर जारी मेरा विरोध कार्यक्रम स्थगित नहीं होगा। भाजपा सांसद ने कहा कि राज ठाकरे ने अपनी पांच जून की प्रस्तावित अयोध्या यात्रा भले ही स्थगित कर दी हो, लेकिन अब भविष्य में कभी भी वह उत्तर भारत के किसी भी प्रांत में कदम रखने की कोशिश करेंगे, तो कोई न कोई युवा उनके विरोध के लिए खड़ा हो जाएगा। ठाकरे ने दिवटर पर कहा कि अयोध्या शहर का उनका दौरा फिलहाल रद्द कर दिया गया।

और वह 22 मई की सुबह पुणे में एक रैली के दौरान इस संबंध में अपनी बात रखेंगे। ठाकरे का टवीट उन खबरों के बीच आया है कि वह स्वस्थ नहीं हैं।

टैकर और ट्रक की भिड़ंत के बाद आग लगी, नौ मरे

चंद्रपुर, 20 मई (भाषा)।

महाराष्ट्र के चंद्रपुर में डीजल से भरे टैकर और लकड़ी ले जा रहे ट्रक के बीच भीषण टक्कर होने के बाद आग लग गई। हादसे में नौ लोगों की झुलस कर मौत हो गई। एक पुलिस अधिकारी ने शुक्रवार को यह जानकारी दी।

उन्होंने बताया कि दुर्घटना गुरुवार रात करीब साढ़े दस बजे चंद्रपुर-मुल रोड पर हुई। चंद्रपुर के अनुविभागीय पुलिस अधिकारी सुधीर नंदनवार ने कहा, चंद्रपुर शहर के पास अजयपुर के निकट डीजल से भरा एक टैकर लकड़ी के लट्टों को ले जा रहे ट्रक से टकरा गया। हादसे से वहां भीषण आग लग गई, जिसमें नौ लोगों की घटनास्थल पर ही मौत हो गई। घन विभाग के सुराों ने बताया कि हादसे के करीब एक घंटे बाद दमकल कर्मी अजयपुर पहुंचे और कुछ घंटों बाद आग पर काबू पा लिया गया।

नंदनवार ने बताया कि पीड़ितों के शवों को बाद में चंद्रपुर अस्पताल ले जाया गया।
