The course is conducted on the guidelines issued by the Director General of Shipping, Mumbai. Cadets passing out from METI will be qualified for induction as Junior Marine Engineers in merchant ships and will obtain part A of class IV certificate of competency from DG shipping. The duration of the residential course is one year. The Marine Engineering training imparted at METI, CSL has a special focus on imparting onboard training to the cadets to familiarize them with the ship environment and onboard equipments
